### Welcome, Roll Call and Approval of Minutes

#### **Anniston Army Depot Munitions Response Sites: Investigation Overview**

Mr. Henn discussed the strategic plan for the southeast industrial area Groundwater Remediation for Anniston Army Depot. He explained the purposes, goals and methodology for the OU1: Focused Feasibility Study and recapped the eight Technical Memoranda (TM) that he discussed at the previous meeting. He also discussed the extreme level of effort that the Anniston Tier I team has put into this project and the big questions they are working to answer.
