Welcome, Roll Call and Approval of Minutes

Tracy Williams opened the meeting by introducing herself to the ANAD RAB members and visitors. She then turned over to Mr. Kothari. Mr. Kothari said that the Commander could not make the meeting and Tracy will be sitting in for him. Mr. Grant called the Roll call.

Southeast Industrial Area Final Focused Feasibility Study for Groundwater Remediation

Keith Henn, Tetra Tech

Mr. Henn made a Power Point presented on the Southwest Industrial Area (SIA) Focus Feasibility Study (FFS) Report. He summarized past cleanup efforts. He also presented conceptual site mode for the site and three-prong approach for remediating the site. Mr. Henn also stated that due to complexities of this site an Interim Record of Decision would be completed.

Remedial Investigation for Military Munitions Program Sites

Tom Weatherly, HGL

Mr. Weatherly made a Power Point presentation on Remedial Investigation on three Military Munitions Response sites. He summarized the past Site Investigations on Burning ground Buffer Zone, Pistol Range and recoilless Rifle Range. He also summarized all the investigation activities at these sites. He mentioned that all reports are not available yet. A Remedial Investigation report will be completed for these sites. Following RI report feasibility Study will be completed to evaluate the remediation alternatives.

Questions from the Audience

Several issues regarding the movement of TCE in the groundwater was discussed. Remediation with and without active remediation was also discussed.
